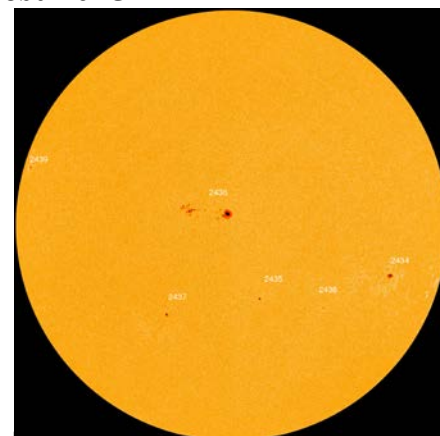

## Propagation Forecast For The CQ World Wide SSB DX Contest 2015

**Solar Activity Forecast:** Solar activity will be low with a chance for M-class flares Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

**Geophysical Activity Forecast:** The geomagnetic field will be at quiet levels on Friday, quiet to minor storm levels on Saturday and unsettled to minor storm levels on Sunday. This week the Solar Flux Index (SFI) has been 120, 124, 123, 129 and 121 (Sunday through Thursday). The K index over the last 24 hours has been 1, 1, 2, 3, 2, 3, 1 and most recently 1 (09Z). The A Index is forecasted to be at 5 today, 5 on Saturday and 5 on Sunday. The SFI is forecasted to be at 120 today and Saturday and 115 on Sunday.

## During The Contest

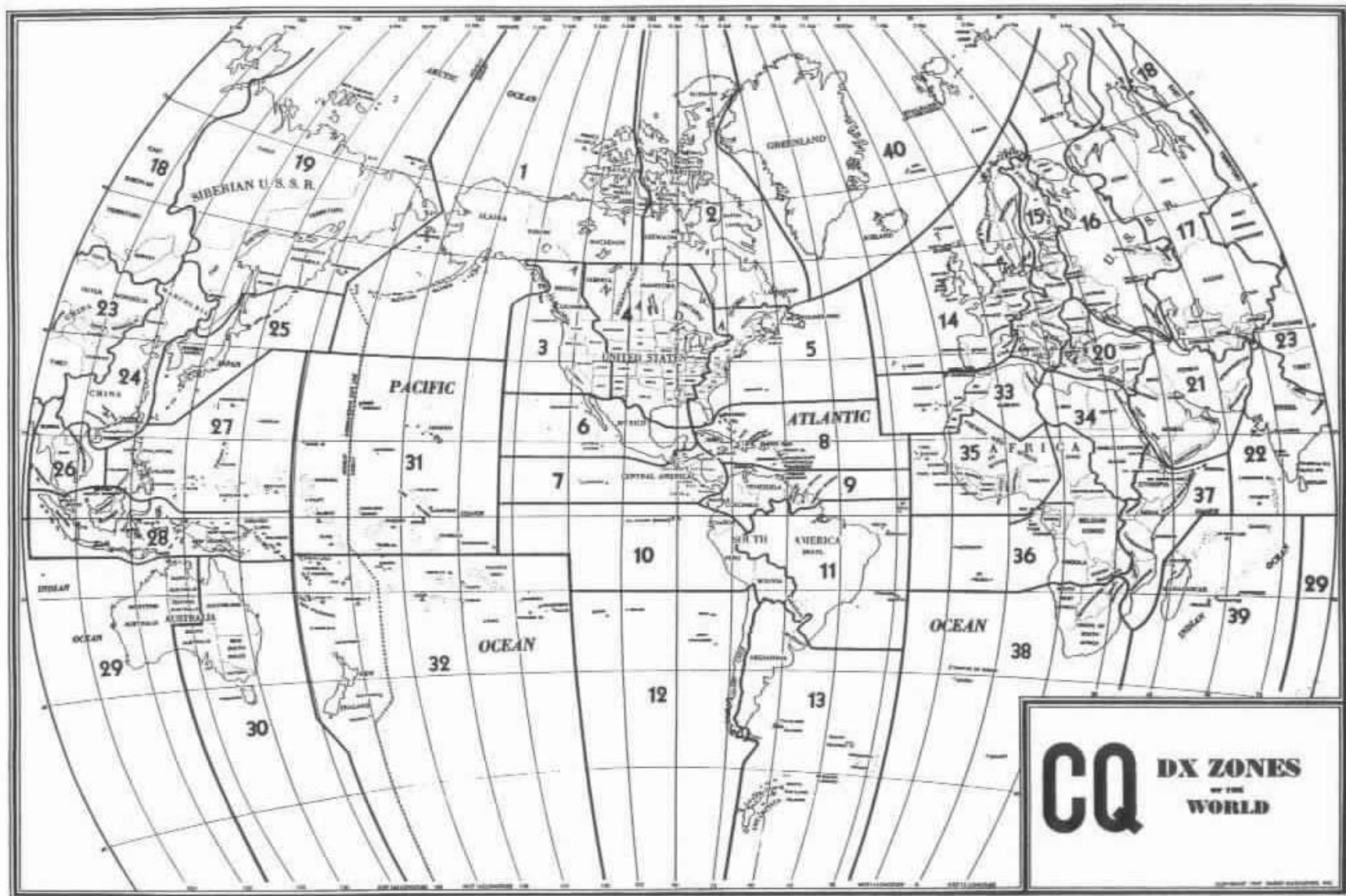
Remember 4U1A or 4U70VIC from Vienna International Center, JW/Bear Island, GM/Shetlands (usually using the GZ prefix), IT9/Sicily, IG9 and IH9 stations from Italian Africa and Z6 Kosovo are all separate multipliers in this contest as are the two Turkey (TA) multipliers. TA1 is in Europe the others are in Asia.
